Roles and responsibilities of the board as a body:

- 1. Establish and be accountable for the mission, values, and vision of St. Augustine Humane Society.
- 2. Develop and Monitor a long-range strategic plan as well as annual action plans.
- 3. Establish policies related to the governance of the organization.
- 4. Approve an annual budget and secure the financial resources necessary to achieve the annual operating goals.
- 5. Employ and review annually the performance of the chief executive officer.
- 6. Assess performance as a board on a regular basis, at least annually.
- 7. Nominate directors who will assure continuity of the highest quality in board Performance and accountability.
- 8. Elect officers who will assure the highest quality of board membership.

Roles and responsibilities of individual directors:

- 1. Support and be faithful to the mission and goals of the organization.
- 2. When acting on behalf of the organization, give priority to its interests, mission, and values.
